A two-time recipient of the U.S. Department of Education's prestigious Blue Ribbon award, St. Hilary School serves students in kindergarten through eighth grade. Children of all backgrounds are guided in building the foundation that will empower them for life.

The school's curriculum challenges and accommodates students of diverse learning abilities and its faculty strives to cultivate the full academic potential of every student. Enhancing the core curriculum are classes in Spanish, French, religion, art, music, physical education and technology. Also available are advanced math classes, an arts-based enrichment program, and a full-service library.



St. Hilary School students have the opportunity to participate in service projects, competitive academic events, extracurricular activities and sports throughout the school year. A state-of-the-art computer lab, 60 laptop computers and SmartBoards in all classrooms put the school on the cutting edge of technology. Guidance, remedial



tutoring, speech and hearing therapy, a nurse-staffed clinic, a daily hot lunch program and extended care are among the amenities offered.

All St. Hilary School grade levels consistently rank at the 98th-99th percentile nationally on the Iowa Test of Basic Skills. Approximately 98 percent of St. Hilary School students choose to continue their education at a Catholic high school. Schools are pleased to accept St. Hilary graduates, who come to them exceptionally well-prepared for the challenges of high school. Many St. Hilary School alumni have been named to the National Honor Society or become National Merit Scholars at their high schools, continuing the tradition of excellence began in their elementary years.

Crystal Commemoratives

These are unique, individually crafted, etched and beveled glass panels, permanently and invisibly bonded to the windows in the connecting hallway between the school and the gymnasium. They are a perfect way to leave a legacy, remember a loved one or celebrate a special event.

Three sizes offer a choice of participation, with the two larger sizes having the advantage of bigger typography for the commemoration.

Because of the permanence of the addition of the panels to the plate glass, they will be affixed to the windows only after a minimum of 50% of the amount pledged has been paid. Since there are a limited number of panels, prime, eye-level spots will be in initial demand and will be placed on a first-pledged basis.

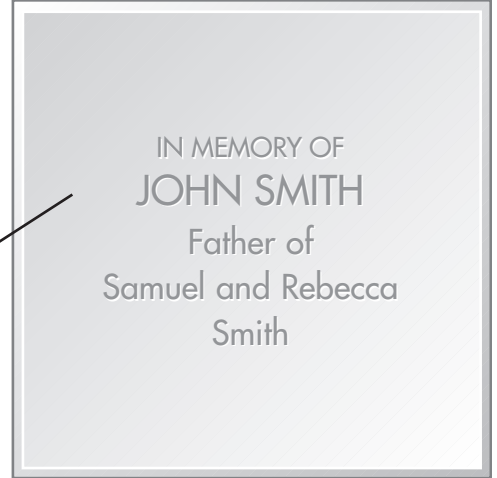
There will be only 152 6"x6" panels, 72 12"x6" panels, and 54 12"x12" panels available.

72 x \$5,000 = \$360,000

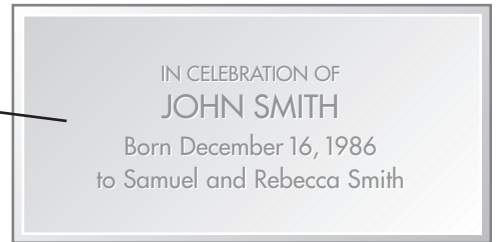
54 x \$10,000 = \$540,000
